Successful Completion of Pre-Pilot Activities

We are excited to share the success of two key pre-pilot initiatives that mark significant progress in our journey toward the major pilots planned for 2025.

1st Pre-Pilot: Train-the-Trainers:

Hosted online by CERTH, took place from October 14 to 18, 2024. During this intensive training week, 26 trainees (two from each partner organization) were certified as trainers. These certified trainers will play a pivotal role in the upcoming learners' pre-pilot in Timisoara and the major pilot sessions scheduled for next year.

2nd Pre-Pilot: Learners:

Organized by ISIM, was held in a hybrid format from November 4 to 8, 2024. This session saw 25 learners (two per partner) actively participating in course activities, with 15 attending in person and 10 joining remotely via MS Teams. This flexible approach ensured accessibility and engagement across locations.

Both pre-pilot activities have set a strong foundation for knowledge transfer and skill-building, preparing us for impactful implementation in 2025.

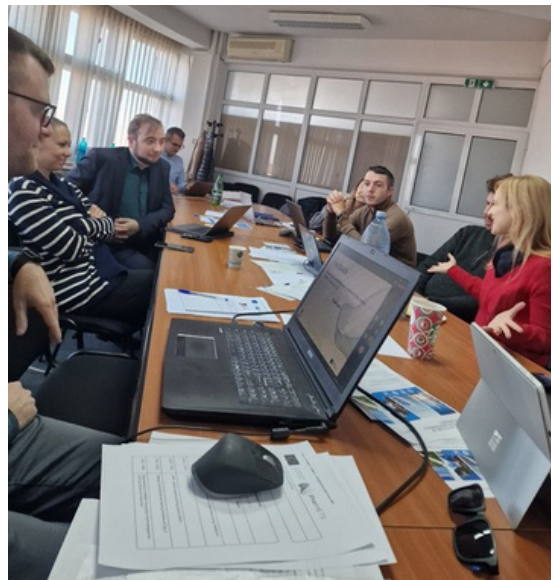


Transnational Project Meeting (4th TPM) - in Timisoara, Romania
