Why? Predictive maintenance plays a critical role in improving infrastructure resilience, reducing costs, and enhancing safety across multiple sectors.



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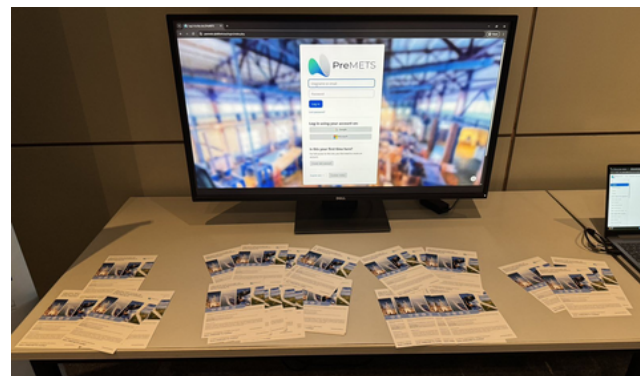

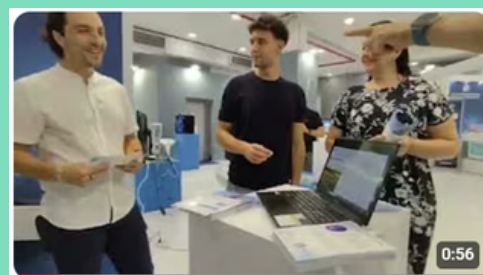
